Terms of Use

This Trademark Usage Policy will show you the proper use of MCC trademarks and logos. The terms of this section apply to the entire MCC Website.

Use the Correct Symbol

When using a MCC trademark in text form ("MCC Mark") use the correct ® or ™ symbol on the most prominent (or if none is prominent, the first) appearance of a MCC Mark.

The basic rule is if you are using a MCC Mark that is registered with the U.S. Patent & Trademark office the ® symbol should be displayed, and if the MCC Mark is not yet registered, the ™ symbol should be displayed. Once a MCC Mark is correctly attributed on a document or web page, it is not ordinarily necessary to mark subsequent appearances of the trademark in the piece. Every appearance of a MCC Mark in stylized form or design ("MCC Logo") should also appear with the appropriate ® or ™ symbol, and may be used only under license from MCC.

Do Not Alter MCC Marks or MCC Logos

When using a MCC Mark, never vary the spelling, add or delete hyphens, make one word two, or use a possessive or plural form of the MCC Mark. When using a MCC Logo, never modify the design, add or delete any words, change any colors or proportions.

Only Use MCC Product Names

Use Footnotes for Correct Attribution

It is MCC's policy to attribute a MCC Mark or MCC Logo use by placing the information in a footnote as follows:

Example: "_____ is a trademark or a registered trademark of the Maranatha Christian Center."

There is no "boilerplate" footnote. The blank space should be a list of all MCC Marks and MCC Logos that appear in that particular piece. If all MCC Marks and MCC Logos are registered trademarks, then the footnote should indicate as such. Footnotes should always be complete sentences, and ordinarily appear on the copyright page, on the last page of the material.

Power Point & Other Presentations
